

PUPILS' ONLINE LEARNING & USE OF ZOOM, SKYPE etc.

In order to increase the interactivity of your sons' education, we will be using video conferencing tools such as Zoom, and the daily timetable of lessons will be tailored to allow this.

Teachers have been advised that there are certain guidelines which must be followed to ensure that safeguarding protocol is adhered to, and parents and pupils should also follow the following principles:

- All video conferencing between teachers & pupils should be treated in the same way as a normal lesson at school, and all behaviour and general conduct should be of the same standard.
- Parents will be given a timetable of scheduled Zoom lessons, in advance but this may be subject to change.
- Pupils should be dressed appropriately, and be in a public area of the house, not in bedrooms.
- A parent or other supervising adult should be in the room during the lesson, or in another room in hearing distance.
- Parents should not take part in the video conferencing themselves, or interrupt the lesson.
